



The British Fuchsia Society – Membership Application Form



The society was formed in 1938 with the object of furthering interest in the cultivation of fuchsias. The fuchsia is very easy to grow and train into numerous shapes and there are so many cultivars of this lovely plant available, with flowers in a wide range of colours that will bloom all summer long. Being such a versatile plant it can be cultivated in different ways and it is not vital to have a heated greenhouse to achieve good results. Our society is open to all.

Joint membership will be accepted at one address only and may be any two people at that address. Renewal forms are sent automatically with the Autumn Bulletin each year. The annual subscription (see Membership Application Form) for overseas membership may be for up to two people at the same address. Overseas members may also pay more than one year's subscription at a time. All publications will be sent via Air Mail.

All members are entitled to:

1. A membership card for each member.
2. A copy of the Society's Constitution (on joining only).
3. The right to attend and vote at the Society's Annual General Meeting.
4. A copy of the Annual and such Bulletins as may be issued during the currency of subscriptions - one copy only to joint members.
5. Free advice on all aspects of Fuchsia culture.
6. The right to exhibit free of charge at any show organised by the Society.
7. The right of entry into any other competition organised by the Society.
8. Participation in the annual free cutting distribution scheme.


A form for the annual free cutting distribution scheme will be sent to members, which only becomes effective when the current year's subscription has been paid by the date specified. Members joining or re-joining after the 1st of January cannot be included in any distribution of cuttings. *This rule will be strictly adhered to.*

We can now accept payment via PayPal but if you choose to pay by this method please add £0.50, as there is an administration charge, to the specific amount detailed above.

All memberships run from 1st November until 31st October each year. You will receive in your joining a copy of a recent publication, a selection of leaflets, a copy of the constitution and membership card, plus all future issues as they become available during the period of your membership.
